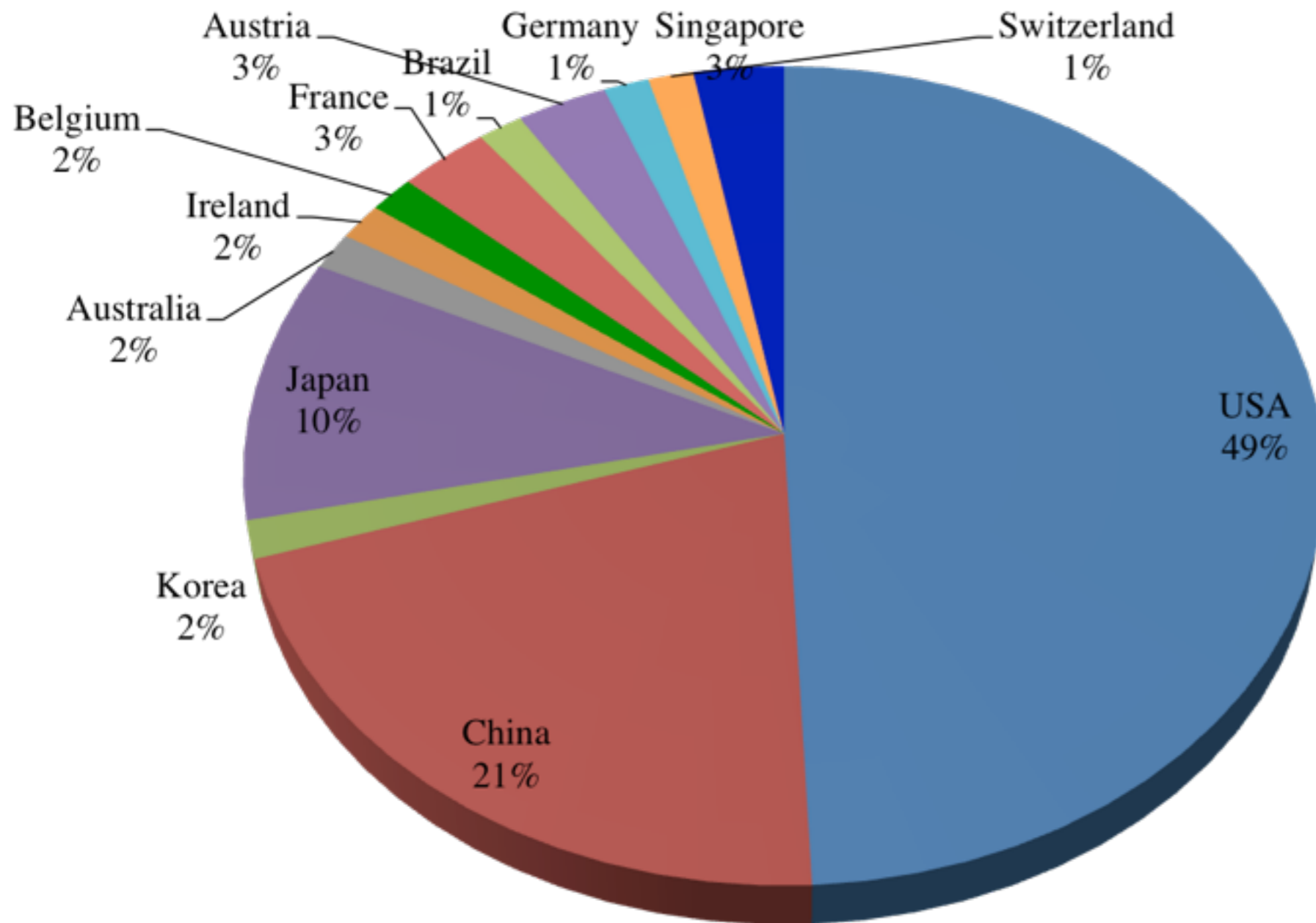

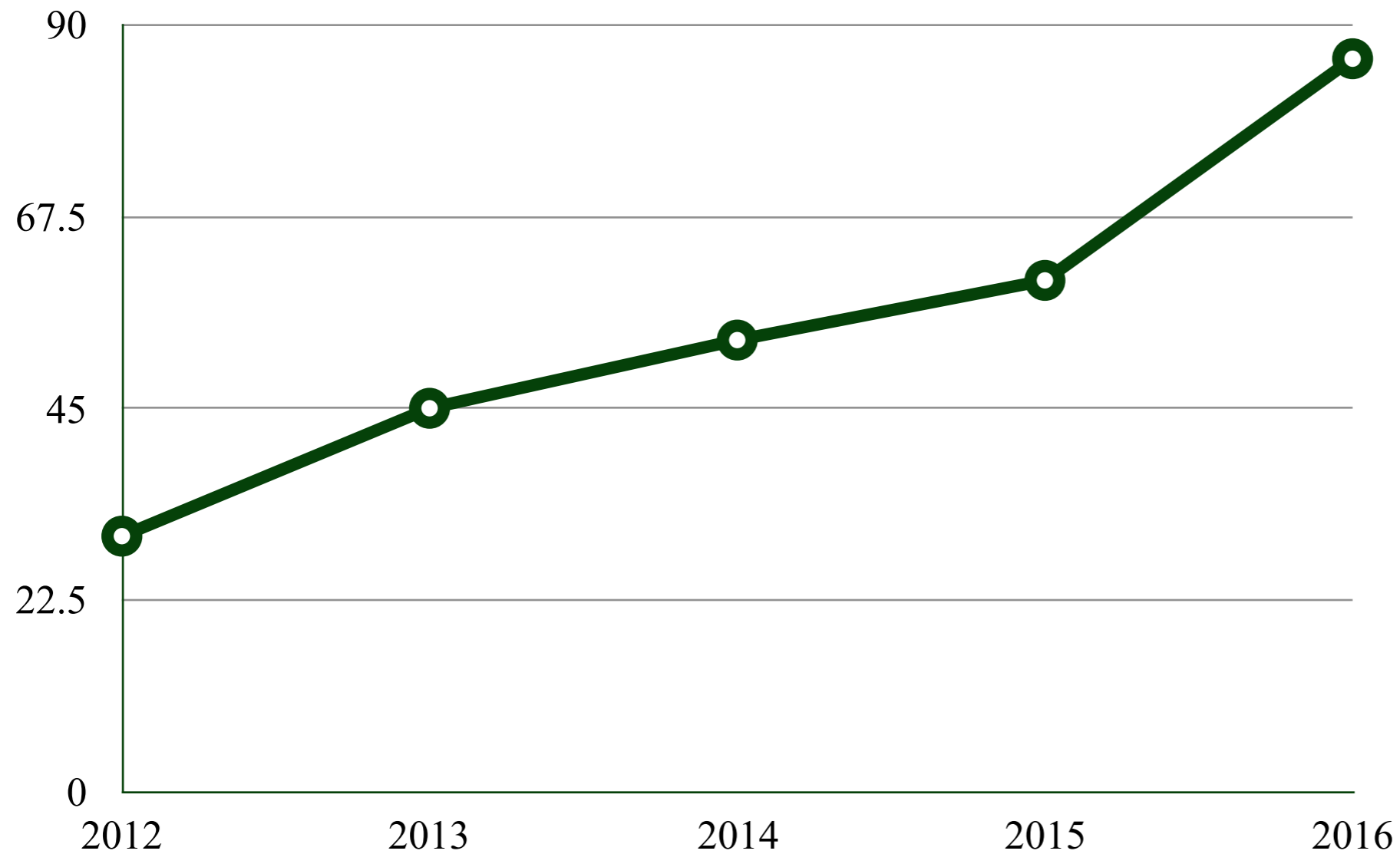

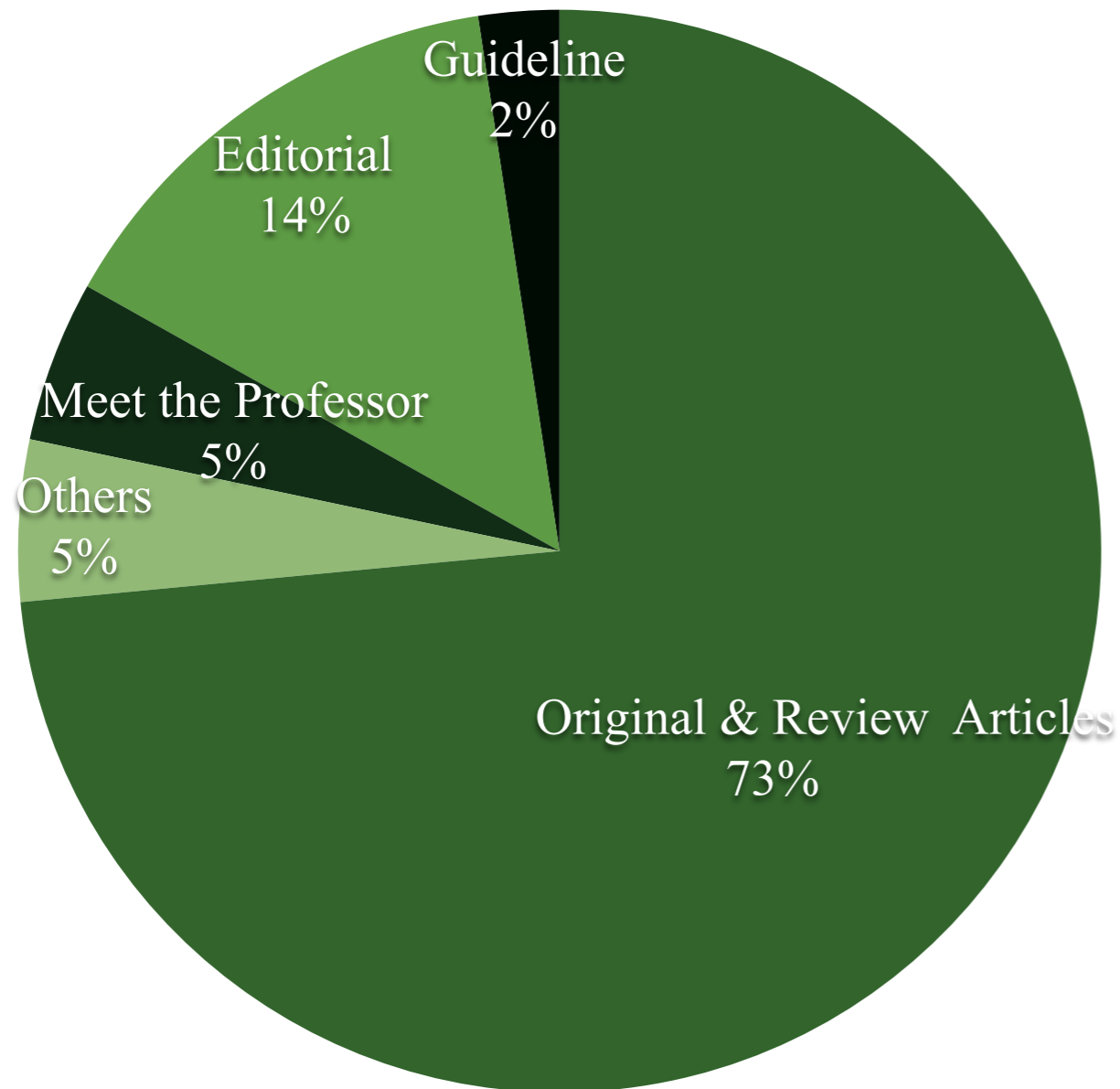
## 4. Number of Published Articles (results by year)

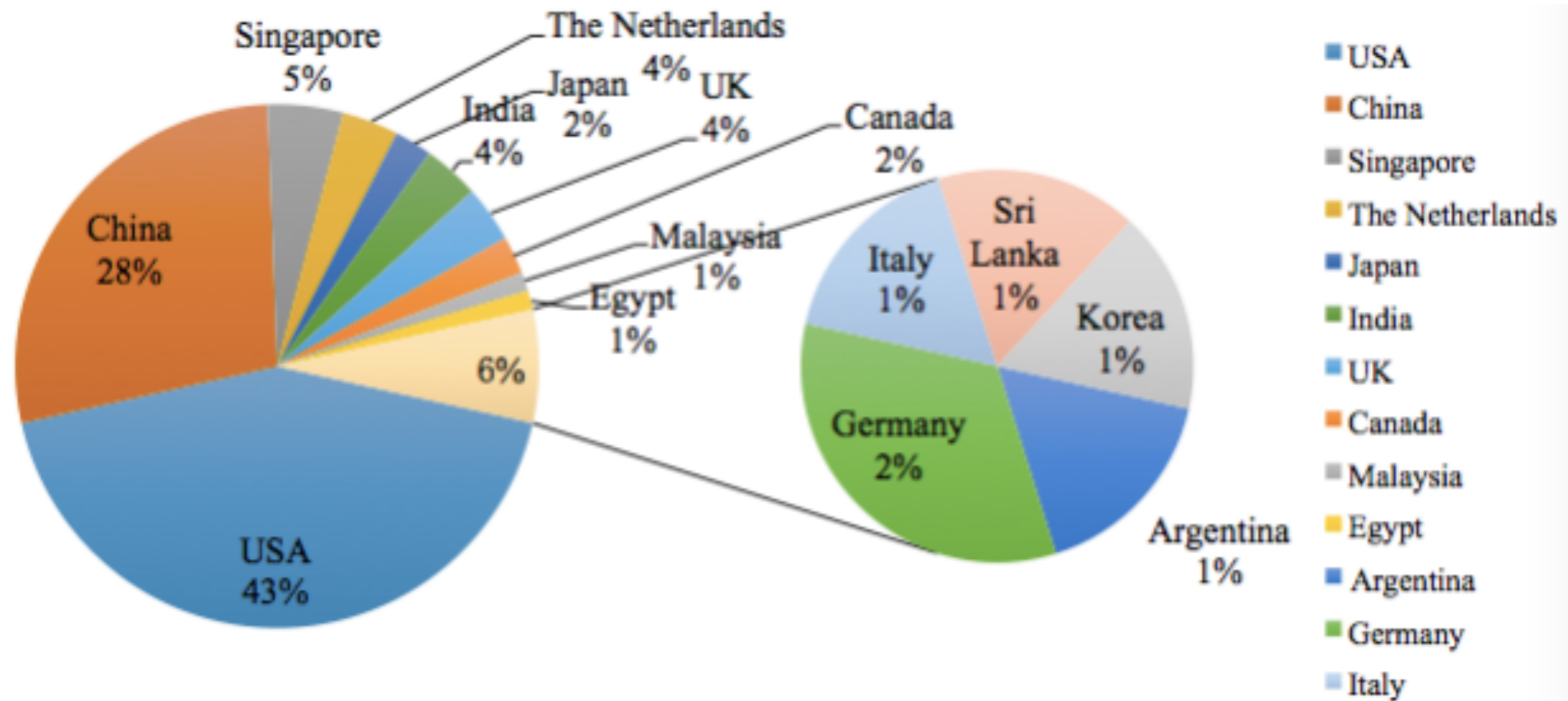

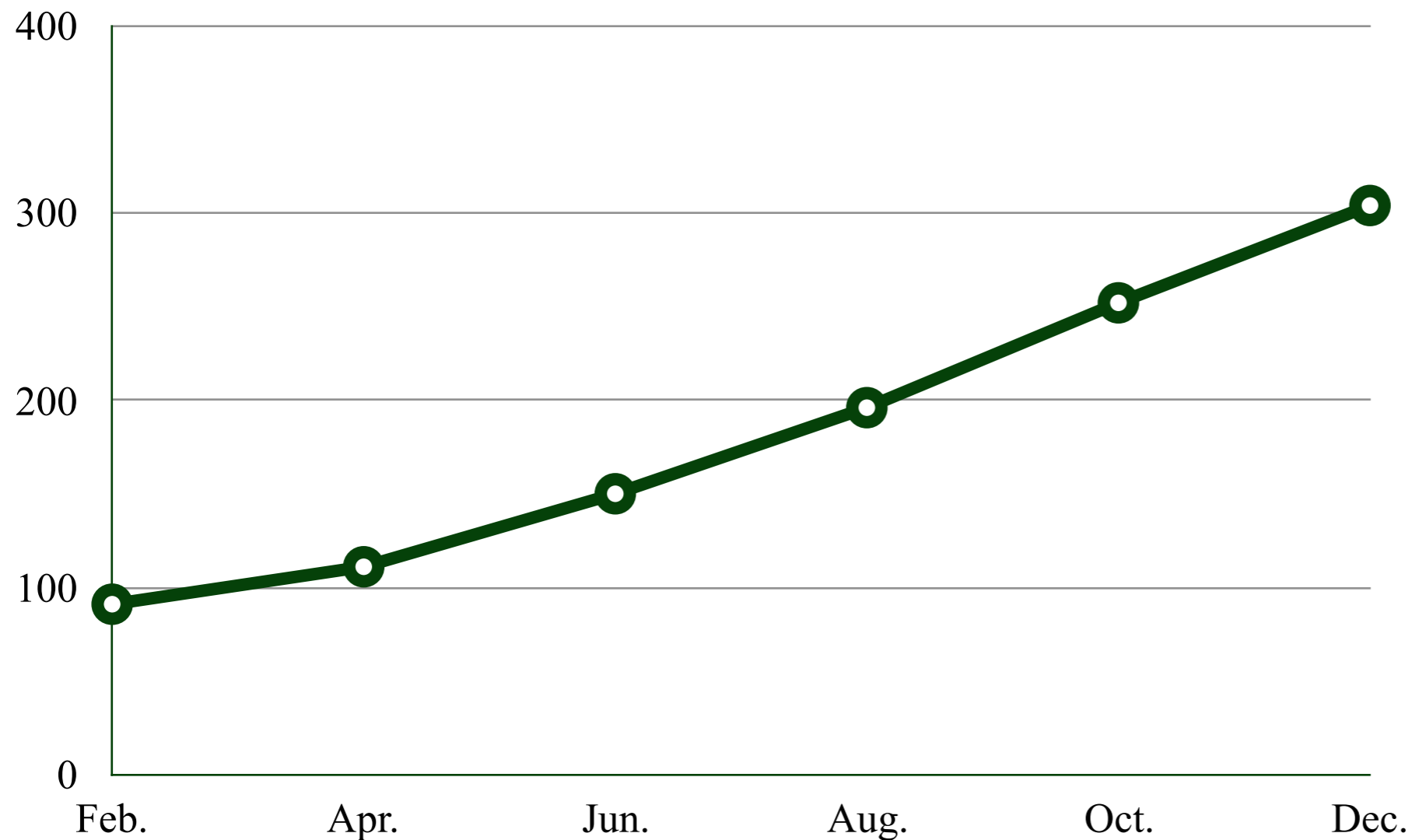
## 6. Distribution of Corresponding Authors in 2016



Corresponding authors of 86 articles published in 2016 come from **15 countries** with 43 % of them from USA.



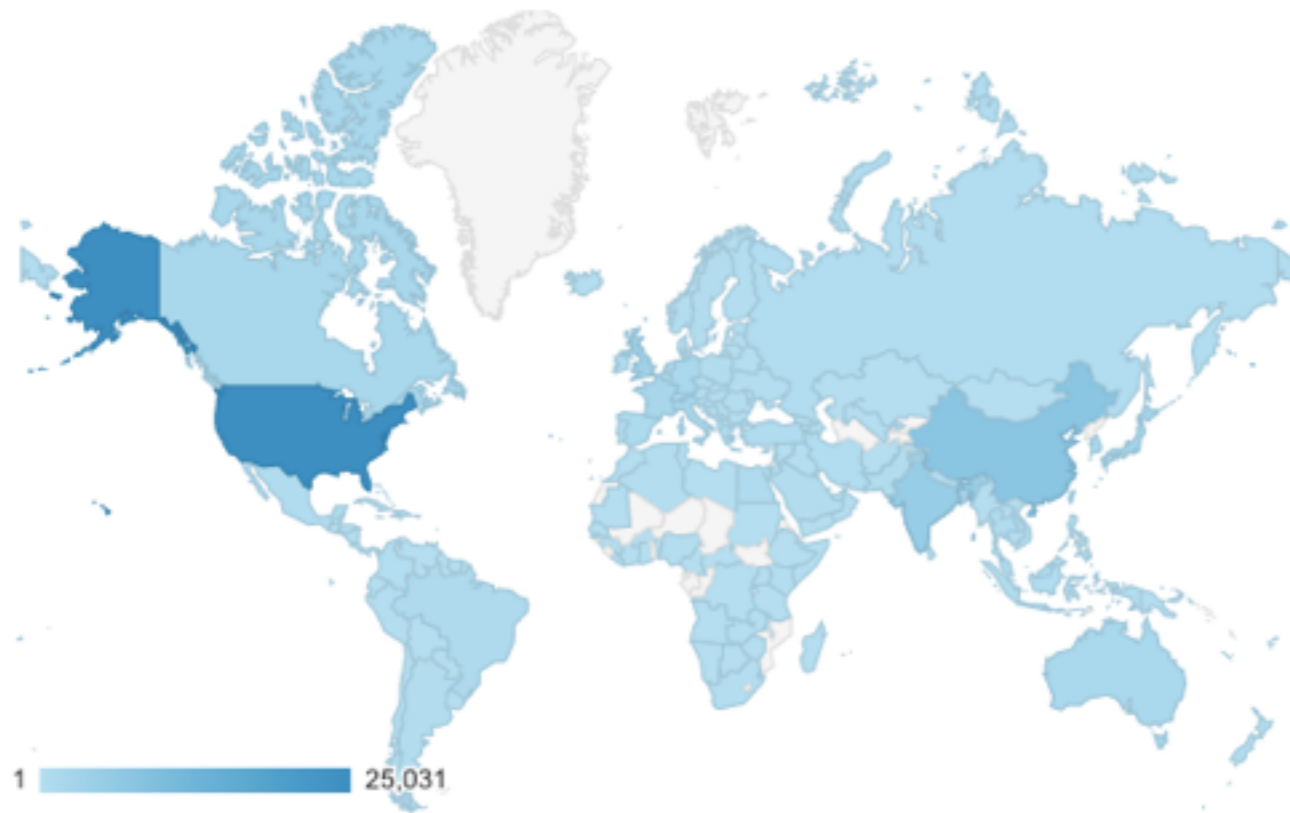
## 7. Citations in 2016 (results by month)

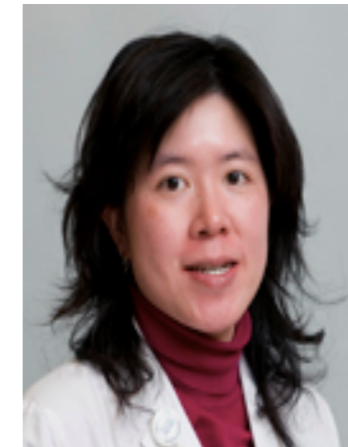

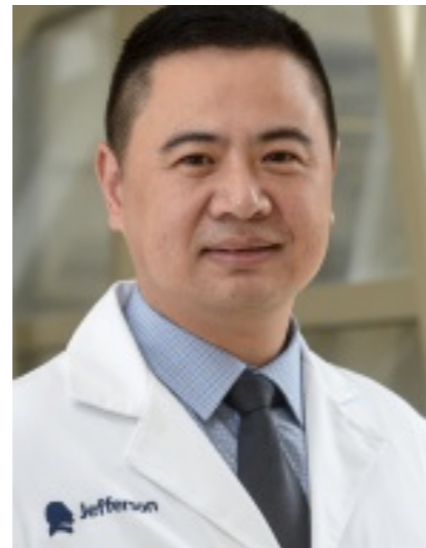

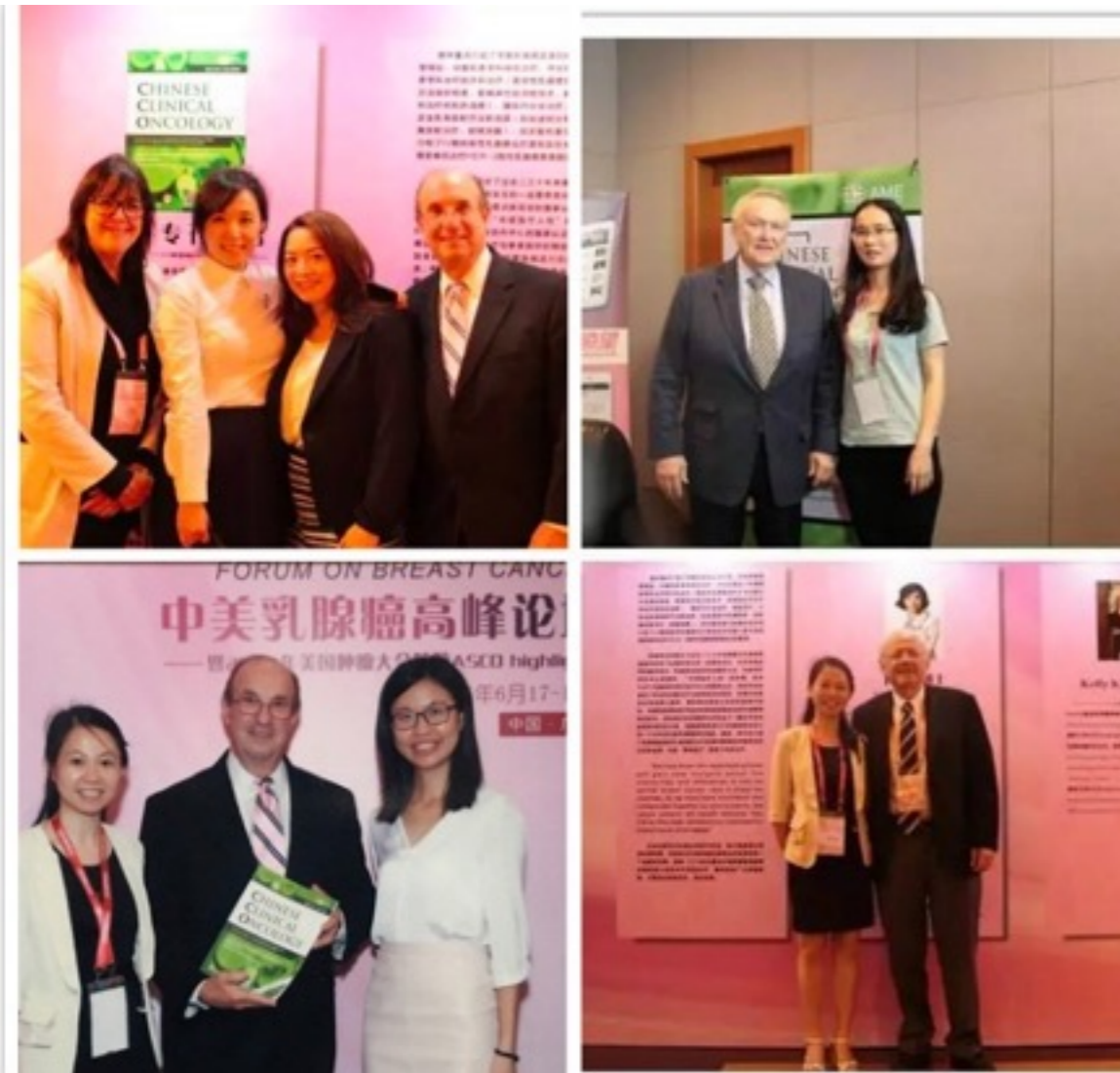
