






3. Distribution of Editorial Board Members





4. Number of Published Articles (results by year)




86 articles published in 2016.

Number of articles has been increasing every year.




5. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2016


6. Distribution of Corresponding Authors in 2016

7. Citations in 2016 (results by month)




Number of total citation has significantly increased to **304** in 2016.




